## SURROUNDING AREAS



## Shonenji

This temple houses the grave of Yoshisada Nitta, a feudal warlord who was killed in battle in the 1300s. Mitsuhide Akechi, another warlord who left us the "Black Hair Legend,"

is also said to have lived here for 10 years in the 1500s.



## Senko no Ie

Featuring a distinctive structure, this is the oldest private house in Fukui, and is also one of the most important historical buildings in Japan.

## Mikuni Minato

Mikuni Minato prospered as a port for Kitamaebune (northern-bound ships), which have been certified as part of Japan Heritage. The historic cityscape evokes the memories and prosperity of bygone days.







## Takidanji

This ancient temple built in the 1300s boasts many temple treasures, some of which are national treasures. Designated as a place of scenic beauty in Japan, the garden is a must-see.

## Mikuni Onsen

## Iki Iki Plaza Kasumi no Sato Onsen

A five-minute drive from Maruoka Castle, this natural hot spring is a great day trip in the idyllic countryside.

## Yourport

A publicly operated natural hot spring where you can enjoy watching the sunset over the Sea of Japan while soaking in a hot bath.





Mikuni Fireworks Display (Mikuni Sunset Beach)

A fireworks display representing Hokuriku, which is held on August 11 each year. Approximately 10,000 fireworks light up the midsummer night sky, while the famous making the water sparkle like giant flowers in the Sea of Japan.



AUTUMN

Mikuni Minato Obi no machinagashi (Mikuni City Center)

Dancers walk in procession dancing through the distinctive city to the tune of "Mikunibushi," a traditional folk song from this region, accompanied by shamisen (traditional Japanese instrument) and flute. "Obi no machi" refers to "a town with narrow streets like kimono sash belts".



WINTER


Held in November when the crab fishing season commences, the festival offers ocean-fresh Echizen crabs.



Maruoka Old Castle Festival

A festival held around Maruoka Castle every October. It features the "Gomangoku Parade," where feudal warlords parade around in a 400-strong entourage.

## Michi-no-Eki Sakai (Sakai Community Center Inesu)


